STANDARDIZED SAFETY SIGNS & LABELS

ANSI [American National Standards Institute] is a private non-profit organization that oversees the development of voluntary consensus standards for products, services, processes, systems and personnel in the United States. These standards depict and explain the unique properties that can alert people to hazards in the workplace and at home.

Though ANSI itself does not develop standards, the Institute oversees the development and use of standards by accrediting the procedures of standards developing organizations. Both ANSI 1967 and ANSI Z535-2011 (R2017) formats are now OSHA compliant forms of safety and hazard communication.



DANGER indicates a hazardous situation which, if not avoided, will result in death or serious injury.



WARNING indicates a hazardous situation which, if not avoided, could result in death or serious injury.



CAUTION indicates a hazardous situation which, if not avoided, could result in minor or moderate injury.



NOTICE is used to address practices not related to physical injury.



Safety instruction (or equivalent) signs indicate specific safety-related instructions or procedures.

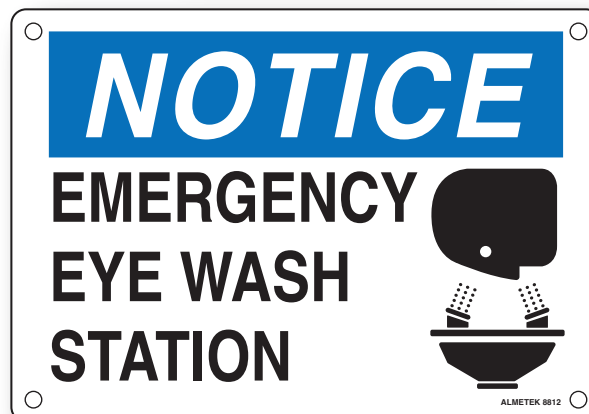
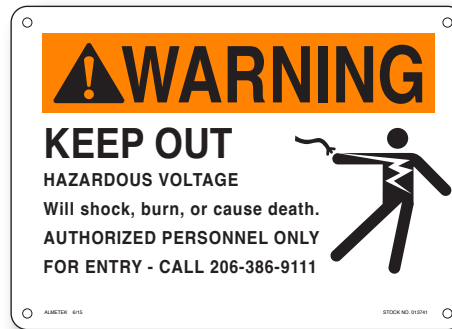
